Bacon County Solar Ordinance: This Ordinance shall amend the Bacon County Solar Farm Ordinance enacted December 17, 2024. Any provision in the Bacon County Solar Farm Ordinance enacted December 17, 2024 that conflicts with this ordinance shall be superseded by the terms of this ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide standards for the installation, operation, and maintenance of solar farms/field to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Bacon County, Georgia.
